

Practical information - submission of abstracts

Abstracts shall consist of maximum 600 words - ½ A4 page and be written in English. Conference contains platform presentations (15 min) and shorter workshop and poster presentations.

The deadline for submission of the abstracts is January 10th 2019. The abstracts should be submitted on www.nordiwa.org. The Programme Committee selects the abstracts and the authors are informed in the end of March 2019. The authors of the selected abstracts must submit a presentation or produce a poster by the end of August. The conference language is English.

Presentations and posters will be published in a digital form and are distributed to the participants at the conference.
